Driving to the Ground



Take Junction 26 on the M6 and join the M58 or Junction 21A M6 then take Junction 6 M62 onto the M57. These motorways converge at a roundabout called Switch Island. Then take the A 567 and make sure that Bootle's ground is to your right. At the first set of lights after the ground the most direct route is to continue straight on until you come to a roundabout in Seaforth (approx. 1 mile from the motorway).

Take the third main exit at the roundabout then at the next roundabout at Seaforth Docks (the Freeport) then follow the sign for Southport/ Crosby A565 and then take the first Left following the sign for Southport then continue down Crosby Road South for about half a mile until you reach a set of traffic lights (with the Liver Pub to the left just ahead). You will then go through two pedestrian lights before the next set of traffic lights at a crossroads. You will see Merchant Taylor's School ahead. Turn left here into College Road and past Victoria Park (on your left) the ground is half a mile on the left. Parking in the club car park is limited to officials and players so park the side roads around the ground.

Public Transport



Train to Blundellsands & Crosby Rail Station then a 13 minutes walk to ground down Kenilworth Road turn left into Mersey Road then cross the road at the library and walk down College Road.



Train to Liverpool Lime Street and from the main entrance then walk 8 minutes over to Queens Square Bus Station and from Stand 11 take the Stagecoach in Merseyside 53 to the corner of Stanley Road and Balliol Roads and then take the Arriva 62 stop at opposite the library on Coronation Road and this is a two minutes' walk to the ground you cross the road and take a right into College Road.



From the North alight at Preston Railway station and walk over to the Railway Stand a on Fishergate and take the X2 Stagecoach in Lancashire to Coronation Drive just before the School then walk back a few yards turn left and walk to the end of Myers Road West and at the end take a right and cross the road the ground is on the left.

The X2 runs every 30 mins on a Saturday 21 and 51 from the railway station just stay on the bus at Southport bus Station and coming back its 14 and 44 on Coronation Drive

From the North take Junction 24 of the M6 and at the end of the slip road take a right onto Liverpool Road (A58) then take the first right into Tithebarn Road then first right into Gibsons Road and at the mini roundabout take the first exit onto Dowall Green Road, at the end of the road take a right and at the sign for the ground take a left into Brocstedes Road and just outside the town you will see a sign for the ground on the right and it a small lane to the ground.

From the South take junction 25 on the M6 and follow the slip road to the roundabout take the second exit and then take a right into Soughers Lane and Premier hair just before Edmunds College Park and at the end of the road take a right into Dowall Green Road continue along to you see the sign for the club then take a right into Brocstedes Road and just outside the town you will see a sign for the ground on the right and it a small lane to the ground.

Train to Garswood Railway Station from the station, then walk up the lane to the Station Hotel turn left (no chance he would never not go for a pint) then take the first right into Victoria Road and walk till the end of the road. Turn right into Billange Road and follow it round as it takes a left bend and at the crossroads walk straight on and walk up the hill take the second left into Booth Brow Road as you get to the end of Garswood there a bungalow take the next right up Brocstedes Road it a slight gradient at for approx. 200 yards before turning right into the ground entrance.

Leave the M66 at junction 3 (Pilsworth) and turn right at end of slip road and Junction 2 from the south and go past Asda and stay on this road until you reach the A56 T-junction, turning right towards Bury. Turn left at the traffic lights onto A6053 Dumers Lane heading for Radcliffe.

Stay on this road, passing the Metrolink station, until you come to the lights at another T-junction. Turn right and follow the Bolton Road round to the left, through a set of lights until you see the Turf Hotel pub, then turn right opposite into Unsworth Street. Ground is on left after two roundabouts and passing the Cricket Club (on the left), by turning into Colshaw Close East.

Train to **Manchester Piccadilly Railway Station** walk over to the tram and take it to **Radcliffe Metro** Link which takes 8 minutes then walk nine minutes to the ground. From M61 Junction 8

Follow the signs for A6 Chorley. At the Hartwood Hall Hotel, turn right onto Euxton Lane. Continue down Euxton Lane (past the hospital) and follow the signs for the A49 Euxton. At the A49, head south for approximately 2-3 miles. At Charnock Richard, turn left onto Church Lane (400 yards after Buy-a-Bike) and then take the next turning right onto Charter Lane with the ground is 400 yards on the right.

From M6 Junction 27

Follow the signs for Standish. At the traffic lights in the centre of Standish turn left and head north on the A49. Keep on the A49 through Coppull, and into Charnock Richard then turn right onto Chorley Lane (B5251) just after the Hinds Head Pub, then continue on the B5251 for approximately $\frac{3}{8}$ mile and take the next turning left onto Charter Lane with the ground is 200 yards on the left.

From M6 Junction 28

At the end of the motorway slip road turn right and travel up to the traffic lights at the junction with the A49. Turn right and head south on the A49 for approximately 4-5 miles, through Euxton, and into Charnock Richard. At Charnock Richard, turn left onto Church Lane (400 yards after Buy-a-Bike) and then take the next turning right onto Charter Lane with the ground is 400 yards on the right.

Driving to the Ground

The ground is situated within 10 minutes of the M6 from Junction 36 take the A590 exit to Barrow/ Kendal and at the roundabout take the first exit onto A590 and keep in the left lane and follow in on to Kendal (South) to the Sundial Guest House. At the first set of traffic lights turn right into Romney Road, then take first exit at the roundabout, then take a right at the lights opposite K Village onto Parkside Road and Lakelands Radio Stadium is on the right over brow of hill.

There is limited parking available on matchdays at the ground, however on road parking can be found nearby. They ask that you do not park on the nearby housing estates, as a courtesy but use the available parking provided.

The main line railway station of Oxenholme is 2 miles from the town centre and the Lakeland Radio Stadium. Or you can use the local line too Kendal there is a train every hour on the half hour it's a 4 minutes journey if you wish. If you come out of Kendal station then turn left as you come out of the main building and walk down Ann Street till you get to the Castle Inn pub then turn left down Castle Street. Walk down to just before the Railway Bridge then turn right this is still Castle Street till you get to the White Bungalow then walk across the park past Kendal Castle and on down walk past the two cricket pitches past the tennis Courts and the ground is in front of you its only 10 mins



From Oxenholme take the 41/41A Stagecoach Cumbria to Burton Road then its five minutes walk to the ground straight up Parkside Road the ground is on the right.

From M6

Exit the M6 at junction 19, and follow the A556 towards Northwich for approximately 3 miles. Turn right onto the A559 towards Lostock Graham (just as the road becomes a dual carriageway). Turn right at the traffic lights immediately before the Slow and Easy pub. Turn left at the crossroads by the Black Greyhound for Northwich. Follow the road through the industrial estate turn left immediately then turn left immediately after crossing the canal bridge at the Carpet Warehouse (signposted) the ground is 100 yards down the lane on the right and you can see the Northwich Victoria Ground across the canal.



From M56

Exit the M56 at junction 10, and follow the A559 (Northwich Road) towards Northwich for approximately 6 miles. (N.B. there is a 30mph limit with speed cameras immediately after turning off the roundabout). Turn right at the crossroads by the Black Greyhound pub for Northwich (The Victoria Ground is Signposted). Follow the road through the industrial estate turn left immediately then turn left immediately after crossing the canal bridge at the Carpet Warehouse (signposted) the ground is 100 yards down the lane on the right and you can see the former Northwich Victoria Ground across the canal.



From M56

Exit the M56 at junction 10, and follow the A559 (Northwich Road) towards Northwich for approximately 6 miles. (N.B. there is a 30mph limit with speed cameras immediately after turning off the roundabout). Turn right at the crossroads by the Black Greyhound pub for Northwich (The Victoria Ground is Signposted). Follow the road through the industrial estate turn left immediately then turn left immediately after crossing the canal bridge at the Carpet Warehouse (signposted) the ground is 100 yards down the lane on the right and you can see the former Northwich Victoria Ground across the canal.

Take the M65 and go to junction 8, and then follow the A6068 (Signposted Clitheroe /Padiham) and then at the traffic lights at the bottom of the hill turn right into Blackburn Road towards Padiham and then at the next junction turn into Holland

Street (opposite the church) then into Well Street to the ground although its best to past in east street as the lane to the ground is very tight.

Take the M1 to Junction 60 and at the roundabout take the third exit and go straight on at the next eight roundabouts at The Three Horses in Kinghall (on your left) take a right onto Otley Road and at the roundabout take the third exit onto the A59 and at the second roundabout take the second exit onto the A65 and at the second roundabout take the Third exit onto the A59 and at the Broughton roundabout take the first exit go past the reservoir and straight on at the next roundabout then at the lights at the crossroads beside Harp ceramics take a right in Colne and at the next roundabout take the Third exit onto the M65 to Junction 13 and take the fourth exit A6068 (A682) then go straight on at the next roundabout keeping on the A6068.



Then after two roundabouts take the signpost left for Padiham (A671) then take the first right at the bus stop in Moor Lane into East Street then follow road right into Well Street there is parking at the bottom of the ground but it best to park in East Street as the road entrance to the ground is very narrow.
